	Park Name	Project Name	Project Description
1			
2	McHenry Community Park	Pavilion at McHenry Community Park – Phase I	Project to build a new pavilion at McHenry Community Park to improve experience for blind camper program and other organizations use of the McHenry Community Park.
3	Eastern Garrett Community Park	Lacrosse Field Conversion	The back ball field is no longer used for the little league but has been transformed into a lacrosse field. The fencing would provide spectator safety and would extend the field to meet better regulations. The basketball court would be partially repurposed for the field and the basketball posts reset in a location allowing for continued use of the hoops.
4	Garrett College	Garrett College Multi-Use Sports Field Upgrades	Garrett College is installing a multi-use turf sports field on the main campus, which addresses a number of inadequacies and areas for improvement over the existing natural grass baseball-only field. Further, it enables the college to offer an on-campus field for women's softball, expand athletics to include soccer programs, and make the fields available for community youth sport use. The funding will be to replace existing fencing with a combination of permanent and portable fencing for maximum flexibility between various sports while being cost effective.
5	Loch Lynn Athletic Fields, Trail & Community Park	Wetland Trail Accessibility Retrofits and Decking Replacement	Replace decking of all boardwalks on wetlands trail and take out bollards and build bump outs so mobility devices can pass on the trails. A Rec Trails grant application has been submitted to supplement project
6	Leo Martin Memorial Park	Restrooms and Storage Building	The Town has been updating this park and it now is a community event space with a pavilion and splash pad. Currently there are port-a-potties for the Splash Pad users. The Town is looking to improve the park by adding the Restroom and Storage Building amenities for the public.
7	Accident Town Park East	Pickle Ball Court	Install a pickle ball court in the southeast corner of Town Park East. The town has received several requests for such a court.
8	Friendsville Recreational Parking Area	Recreational Parking Lot Pavilion	Recreational Park pavilion 12 feet wide x 20 feet long. This pavilion will be used for the boaters and kayakers who come into the town to enjoy the Yough River. It will also be for those visiting the Veterans Memorial located next to the pavilion. As well as the ones that are using the car chargers that are located at the entrance of the parking lot.
9	Grantsville Town Park	Grantsville Town Park Improvements 2024	The Town of Grantsville has prioritized safety, handicapped accessibility, and keep the existing park amenities in good condition. The Town is using this funding to purchase sand and borders for volleyball courts, upgrading the horseshoe and bocce ball courts, add a musical component to the playground area, and replace engineered wood carpet at playgrounds with synthetic rubber surfacing.
10	Acquisition Project	Park Improvements 2023 - Field Acquisition	The Town of Grantsville has recently been presented with the opportunity to buy land on Route 669 in town and expand our park. Our Little League and Softball fields are very heavily used, we frequently have Little League games being played well past 10:00pm at night. We are very interested in expanding and adding onto our town park borders to include the existing baseball field there and add a second one at the location. There is five acres there that we would buying some of.
11	Kitzmiller Elementary School	Portable Stage	The town of Kitzmiller holds many events on the for Kitzmiller Elementary School's field. A lot of these events require the building of scaffolding that we have been using for several years. We believe that a portable stage would be more efficient to be able to provide that space needed for these events. Kitzmiller Homecoming, on July 22, 2023 is one of those events. We are also looking at trying to incorporate the performing arts into our events as well. We also use this scaffolding for drive-in movie nights hosted by one of our local non-profit groups as well as other events. This would help us tremendously by saving us on time for the construction of the scaffolding, and money, to pay those to put the scaffolding up.
12	Glades Park	Glades Park Pickleball Standards and Security System	The Town of Oakland wishes to obtain grant funding to help cover the cost of securing standards/nets for the new pickleball courts at the Glades Town Park. In addition, the Town would like to install security cameras to protect its investment at the Glades Park.
13	Piney Reservoir	Piney Reservoir ADA Fishing Pier	These additional funds are to amend POS 7525-11-287, to complete the parking area enhancements surrounding the pier. The focus is on ensuring fully ADA-compliant parking facilities, complementing the accessible fishing pier to provide a seamless and inclusive experience for all visitors to Piney Reservoir. This joint effort underscores our commitment to accessibility and enjoyment of recreational fishing opportunities within our community.
14	Broadford Park	Broadford Park Pavilions 3 & 4 Improvements	To make the pavilions more handicap accessible, the Town wishes to have a concrete pad poured in each of the pavilions 3 & 4 at Broadford Park. In addition, the Town wishes to have a security camera system installed at this location to protect its investment in the park.
15	No project #1	Ballfield Improvements	A local little league association just took over the operations and maintenance of the County Park with a ballfield. This project is to add shade structures or the players and improve the seating for game attendees.






5. Wetland Trail Accessibility Retrofits and Decking Replacement Loch Lynn Heights








6. Restroom and Storage Building Mountain Lake Park


















