Program Open Space


- ➤ Generated by real estate transfer tax (.5%)

MALPF	\$11.8 million











Green Infrastructure




Water Quality Protection











Rare Species Habitats




Aquatic Life Hotspots











Stewardship Review:

- Collaborative review by DNR's experts and thorough consideration of resource information
- Holistic consideration of management working lands (farms/forests), structures, resident curatorships, trails, restoration, survey questions
- Final recommendation





- 95% of State-side funds used for ecologically significant acquisitions
- Since 2007, about half of State-side acquisitions have been forested land
- In FY 2010 77% of the State's acquisitions were forests!
