

The Lower Potomac River Water Trail Map Set

The Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is pleased to offer the Lower Potomac River Water Trail map set. This is a guide that every boater, kayaker and canoeist will want to keep on hand as it will become an invaluable part of any trip along the southern Potomac.

The six-map set highlights access points along the southern reaches of the Potomac River from Washington D.C. to the Chesapeake Bay in both Maryland and Virginia. Information on each access point, including the availability of restrooms, boating facilities, historical interest, overnight accommodations, camping and food service are included on each map. The water trail maps also include GPS (Global Positioning System) information on access sites as well as boating safety tips and emergency phone numbers.

Maps can be purchased in person at the visitor centers of following State Parks in Maryland: Smallwood State Park in Charles County and Point Lookout State Park, St. Mary's County or at the office of the Boating Services Unit / Water Trails Program in Annapolis, MD.
